From The Bridge:

Once again the Commodore's Ball was held at Duck's on the Boof, Feb. 26th. This year Tenny Meson did a good job at organizing the party.

A good time was had by all with several guests in attendance from other clubs in the area and River Isles Yachting Association.

A gentleman, most of the membership has not met but has certainly heard of, is back from a voyage that has taken him to England and Europe; in a shark no less. Randal Peart joined La Salle Mariners in April of 1968. Four years ago he trailored his shark from Metro Motors on Howard Avenue to Florida then on to England and Europe. We are trying to have a slide night with Randal Peart, later in March or early April. You will be notified. Randal returned to Florida where he sold his shark with 10,000 miles on it and the original set of 12 year old Boston Sails.

Your old key for the clubhouse will only work on the front door. A new lock has been installed on the back door and new keys will be available at the next general meeting.

Besides the new lock working, the 'herds' are now in working order.

PHASE I of the North Herbour is completed by Bondy Exceveting. The leveling of the earth is to be completed in the Spring.

PHASE II has been given to Ron tage of Bee Marine, Harrow to do the dredging from where Bondy ended to a denth of 12° deep into the river. Also Bee Marine will install 30 bilings for dooks both in the North Harbour and in the Southeast Harbour or also known as the 'Small Boat Harbour'. Bee Marine's tender is for #2500.00. Mulhull's original tender of approximately \$2250.00 to complete the job, inflated to \$3450.00 because the cost of driving 22 foot bilings at \$60.00 abject went to \$90.00 epiece for 30 foot bilings in the first place and using the 8 foot section near the shore end of the dock. In short we were setting "driver". PHASE II is expected to start in about two weeks.

PHASE III (namely that of building docks) has started with the purchase of 840 board feet of dock stringers. Ralph Fiedler Harbour Mester, will be calling on several members to start in construction of these docks. Many thanks to Dale Souilliere for trucking the stringers and John Bech for the use of his trailer.

As you may note that the new Harbour is 12' deep this should make LaSalle Mariners the deepest Harbour around. Right now the water is very low. Mariner's Reef is now Mariners Island.

With the werm weather on its way Spring Cleaning the Club will commence soon so we will have enough time to work on our hoats. Howard Porter needs painters and neople to do odds & ends, so give him a call now at 252-0033.

Besides docks, clubhouse cleaning and painting, four mechanical types are needed to work on the Race Committee boat. Those interested cell commodore Hendel = 256-0864. Painters are also needed to facelift the R.C. bost.

We have two applications for membership on the board; Mr. John Parks, a teacher, who sails a shark (which used to be Kevin Hart's) and Mr. John Grey, who works at CHE-T, and sails a Hughes 29.
