Harbour plan to be unveiled on Oct. 30

It's getting close to that time of year when thoughts of sailing reluctantly turn to the realities of Haulout.

The pre-haulout general meeting is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 30 at 1 p.m. and Commodore Brian Lawson and Harbourmaster Ralph Fiedler will be presenting a proposal to enlarge the north harbour.

The idea is to extend the steel breakwall about 35 feet to the west and excavate the area which would include the existing gin pole. The gin pole would be moved to a new location.

The proposal was discussed at the Oct. 4 executive meeting and will be formally presented at the Oct. 30 meeting. Commodore Brian is hoping for a good turnout to discuss this important matter.

And Vice Commodore Bob Reaume wants a good turnout for the work party after the meeting to arrange cradles for Haulout.
