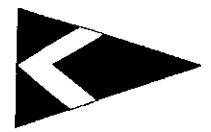

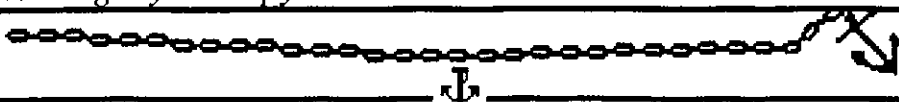
Please call Elaine at 978-9820 to obtain a T-Shirt. All purchases of shirts will be entered into a draw for a Hospice chair. Good Luck to all.

## Highlight of August 24<sup>th</sup> General Meeting

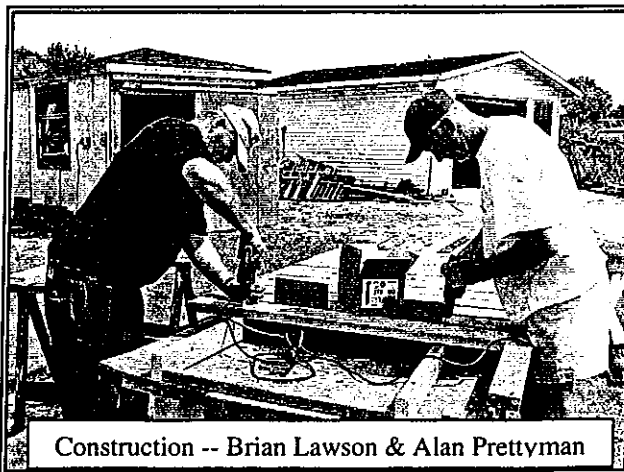

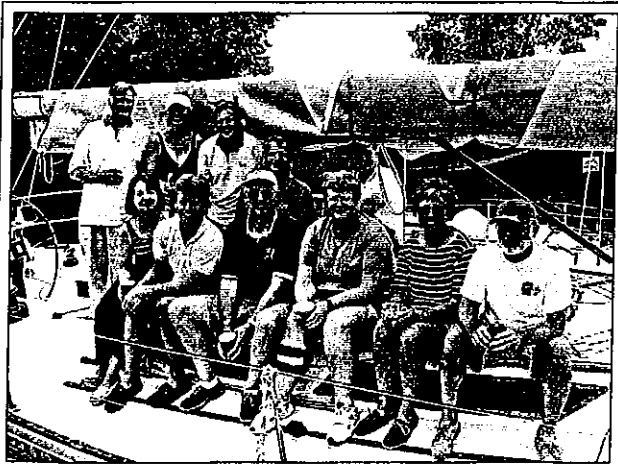
